We close out the EFL Cup quarter-finals on Wednesday night with Newcastle United hosting Fulham at St James' Park, where a place in the semi-finals is on the line.

Match: Newcastle United vs Fulham

Competition: EFL Cup – Quarter-Final

Summary

Newcastle United come into this quarter-final as clear favourites, reflected by the 1.72 price, and home advantage at St James' Park remains a significant edge in knockout football. Eddie Howe's side have consistently shown attacking intent in cup competitions, particularly at home, where tempo and pressing intensity tend to be higher than in league fixtures.

Fulham, meanwhile, arrive as underdogs but are not without threat. Marco Silva's side have demonstrated an ability to score away from home against stronger opposition, often playing with less pressure in knockout scenarios. However,

defensive fragility has been a recurring issue on their travels, especially when facing teams that apply sustained pressure in advanced areas.

The market slightly underestimates Fulham's chances of contributing offensively, while Newcastle's strong likelihood of progressing at home remains the dominant narrative. This points away from the short Newcastle win price and towards a correlated market that better reflects both teams' profiles.

With Newcastle expected to control large spells and Fulham capable of finding the net, a home win combined with goals at both ends offers a stronger value proposition than the standalone match odds.

Recommendation

Value Assessment

Value Rationale

- Newcastle's home win probability remains strong in a single-leg quarter-final at St James' Park.
- Fulham retain credible away scoring potential in cup matches, particularly when operating without league-table pressure.
- The price available at 3.45 creates a **clear mispricing**, significantly improving the risk-reward profile versus the straight home win at 1.72.

- This price sees the selection firmly into **top-tier value territory**.
