Today our focus turns to the Premier League, where Crystal Palace host Everton at Selhurst Park in a fixture that may be shaped as much by scheduling and motivation as by pure league position.

Fixture: Crystal Palace vs Everton

Competition: English Premier League

Date: Sunday, 10 May 2026

Kick-Off: 14:00 GMT

Venue: Selhurst Park, London

Summary

Crystal Palace are priced at 3.25, Everton at 2.46, with the draw available at 3.45.

While the market makes Everton only moderate favourites, the wider data and situational factors suggest the away side may hold a stronger edge than those prices imply.

Both sides have actually performed better away from home than at their own stadiums this season:

- Crystal Palace average 1.35 points per game away, but only 1.18 at home
- Everton average 1.47 points per game away, compared to 1.28 at home

That immediately weakens the traditional home advantage angle normally associated with Selhurst Park.

The scheduling dynamic also appears important here.

Crystal Palace played on 7 May in the UEFA Conference League semi-final and successfully progressed to the final. While confidence will naturally be high, there is also the possibility of both physical fatigue and emotional drop-off entering this league fixture only three days later.

Everton, meanwhile, have had an additional three days of recovery and preparation time, with full focus remaining on domestic competition.

Recent form also leans toward the visitors:

- Everton drew 3-3 with Manchester City in their last match, producing a strong attacking display
- Crystal Palace are without a league win in their last three matches
- Everton continue to show stronger overall defensive structure and more reliable away performances

The underlying metrics also favour Everton slightly:

- Better overall xG differential
- More consistent attacking production
- Higher shot-on-target output in recent matches
- Stronger transitional threat against open sides

The goals markets appear relatively efficient. BTTS Yes at 1.76 and Over 2.5 Goals at 1.95 both require a fairly aggressive game-state projection and do not appear to offer sufficient value from a PGX5 perspective.

Instead, the cleaner angle remains Everton in the match odds market.

Considering Everton's stronger away profile, additional recovery time, and Palace potentially experiencing a post-European emotional comedown, the current 2.50 price looks slightly bigger than it should be.

Why this represents value

The market price of 2.46 implies an approximate probability of 40%.

Based on Everton's stronger away form, superior recent league profile, extra recovery time, and Crystal Palace potentially coming down emotionally after European qualification, Everton's true probability appears closer to 44–46%.

That creates a solid positive edge at the current exchange price.

Final Word

This may ultimately prove to be a more controlled Premier League fixture than the goals markets currently imply.

Crystal Palace come into the game after a major European occasion just three days earlier, while Everton arrive fresher, more focused on league matters, and carrying stronger away form metrics throughout the season.

From a PGX5 perspective, the straight Everton win continues to provide the clearest combination of simplicity, value, and situational support at the current market price.

Everton at 2.46 is the preferred PGX5 recommendation.
