



# FIFA World Cup 2026 | Group Qualification Report

## Group A

### Teams

- Mexico
- South Africa
- South Korea
- Czech Republic

Group A features co-hosts Mexico alongside South Africa, South Korea, and Czech Republic. On paper, it is one of the more balanced groups in the tournament, with no traditional elite European or South American powerhouse present.

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### 1 Group Overview

✓ **Group Difficulty:** Moderate

✓ **Market Narrative:** Mexico expected to qualify comfortably due to home advantage and seeding.

✓ **Potential Market Inefficiency:** South Korea and Czech Republic may be closer in strength than qualification prices imply.

✓ **Key Question:** Does Mexico justify favourite status at short odds, or is there better value elsewhere?

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## **2 Team Profiles**

### **Mexico**

**Estimated Qualification Probability: 78%**

#### **Positives**

- ✓ Co-host nation
- ✓ Vast tournament experience
- ✓ Familiar conditions
- ✓ Traditionally strong group-stage performer

#### **Concerns**

- ✓ Recent tournaments have seen limited progression beyond Round of 16
- ✓ Attacking ceiling not at elite level
- ✓ Increased pressure from home expectations

#### **Assessment**

Mexico remain deserved favourites to qualify. The expanded format also benefits them, reducing qualification risk.

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### **South Korea**

**Estimated Qualification Probability: 62%**

#### **Positives**

- ✓ Technically strong squad
- ✓ High-intensity pressing style

✓ Consistent World Cup qualification history

✓ Strong tactical organisation

### **Concerns**

✓ Sometimes struggle against physically stronger opposition

✓ Goal production can fluctuate

### **Assessment**

Arguably the most balanced team in the group outside Mexico.

Potentially underrated by casual markets.

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## **Czech Republic**

**Estimated Qualification Probability:** 48%

### **Positives**

✓ European tactical structure

✓ Competitive qualifying campaign

✓ Physical profile suits tournament football

### **Concerns**

✓ Lack of elite attacking talent

✓ Limited margin for error

### **Assessment**

A genuine contender for second place.

Likely to be involved in a direct qualification battle with South Korea.

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## **South Africa**

**Estimated Qualification Probability: 32%**

### **Positives**

- ✓ Athletic profile
- ✓ Capable of frustrating stronger teams
- ✓ Dangerous in transition

### **Concerns**

- ✓ Lowest overall squad quality in the group
- ✓ Limited World Cup pedigree
- ✓ Finishing efficiency concerns

### **Assessment**

Clear outsiders but not without upset potential.

Could become an important spoiler.

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## **3 Group Qualification Model**

South Korea	62%

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## **4 Key Group Dynamics**

### **Mexico vs South Korea**

Potential group winner decider.

Mexico likely controls possession.

South Korea capable of exploiting transitions.

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### **South Korea vs Czech Republic**

Potential qualification swing match.

Could effectively decide second place.

Likely low-scoring and tactically cautious.

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### **South Africa's Role**

South Africa may ultimately determine qualification outcomes.

Taking points from either South Korea or Czech Republic could dramatically alter the group.

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## **5 Qualification Summary**

### **Most Likely Outcome**

- 1 Mexico
- 2 South Korea
- 3 Czech Republic
- 4 South Africa

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## Market Assessment

Mexico appear correctly favoured.

The real value may exist in the battle for second place.

Many bettors will automatically gravitate toward Mexico, but the stronger angle may be identifying which side emerges from the South Korea vs Czech Republic battle.

✓ **Selection:** South Korea

✓ **Estimated Probability:** 62%

✓ **Fair Price:** 1.61

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### Secondary Value Angle

✓ **Market:** To Qualify From Group

✓ **Selection:** Czech Republic

✓ **Estimated Probability:** 48%

✓ **Fair Price:** 2.08

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## 7 Value Assessment

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### Early World Cup Report View

This is not a group where backing the favourite appears particularly attractive.

The stronger ante-post angle is likely to come from correctly assessing the **South Korea vs Czech Republic qualification race**.

At first glance:

- ✓ Mexico remain strong favourites to advance.
- ✓ South Korea appear the most likely second qualifier.
- ✓ Czech Republic are capable of upsetting market expectations if priced generously.
- ✓ South Africa look more dangerous as a spoiler than a genuine qualification candidate.

This is exactly the type of group where ante-post value can emerge once Betfair qualification markets settle and public money begins concentrating on the seeded nation.
