



# FIFA World Cup 2026 | Group Qualification Report

## Group D

### Teams

- Denmark
- Tunisia
- Australia
- Costa Rica

Group D is an intriguing mix of European, African, Asian, and CONCACAF representation. Denmark arrive as favourites based on recent qualifying performance, while Tunisia, Australia, and Costa Rica all possess the capacity to contest for the second spot. This group offers potential ante-post value outside of the main favourite.

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### 1 Group Overview

✓ **Group Difficulty:** Moderate

✓ **Market Narrative:** Denmark are the clear favourite to qualify.

✓ **Potential Market Inefficiency:** Australia and Tunisia may be underpriced relative to actual qualification probability.

✓ **Key Question:** Can an outsider challenge Denmark, or will the top-seeded nation advance comfortably?

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## 2 Team Profiles

### Denmark

**Estimated Qualification Probability: 78%**

#### Positives

- Strong European qualification campaign
- Balanced squad across positions
- Tactical flexibility under experienced manager

#### Concerns

- Can be vulnerable to high-intensity pressing teams
- Knockout-stage experience may not fully translate to group dynamics

#### Assessment

Denmark are the favourite to top the group and should qualify without major issues.

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### Tunisia

**Estimated Qualification Probability: 55%**

#### Positives

- Solid defensive organisation
- Experienced squad from previous World Cups
- Capable of frustrating technically superior teams

#### Concerns

- Goal-scoring may be inconsistent
- Can be exposed by high-quality European sides

## **Assessment**

Tunisia are strong candidates for second place, and market odds may underestimate their potential.

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## **Australia**

**Estimated Qualification Probability: 50%**

### **Positives**

- Athletic and disciplined team
- Strong recent qualifying form
- Capable of exploiting transitional play

### **Concerns**

- Limited top-level experience in World Cups
- Margin for error is low

## **Assessment**

Australia are a genuine contender for second place and represent a potential value angle for ante-post bets.

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## **Costa Rica**

**Estimated Qualification Probability: 30%**

### **Positives**

- Experienced in previous World Cups
- Solid defensive structure
- Able to frustrate stronger teams

### **Concerns**

- Attacking output limited

- Limited squad depth

### **Assessment**

Clear outsiders. Could influence outcomes as a spoiler.

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### **3 Group Qualification Model**

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### **4 Key Group Dynamics**

#### **Denmark vs Tunisia**

Potential group winner decider. Denmark likely control possession; Tunisia may frustrate and limit scoring.

#### **Australia vs Costa Rica**

Crucial match for second place. Australia expected to dominate possession and create scoring chances.

#### **Tunisia vs Australia**

Key qualification swing match. Could determine who joins Denmark in the knockout phase.

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## 6 Ante-Post Betting Recommendations

### Primary Selection

- ✓ **Market:** To Qualify From Group D
- ✓ **Selection:** Tunisia
- ✓ **Estimated Probability:** 55%
- ✓ **Fair Price:** 1.82

*Rationale:* Experienced and defensively sound; market may slightly undervalue their chances.

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### Secondary Value Angle

- ✓ **Market:** To Qualify From Group D
- ✓ **Selection:** Australia
- ✓ **Estimated Probability:** 50%
- ✓ **Fair Price:** 2.00

*Rationale:* Underrated by public perception; disciplined team capable of securing key points.

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## 7 Value Assessment

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### **Early View**

- Denmark should top the group comfortably.
- Tunisia are slightly undervalued by the market and represent a strong ante-post pick.
- Australia may offer additional value, particularly if their qualification market drifts beyond 2.00.
- Costa Rica are unlikely to qualify but could act as spoilers.
